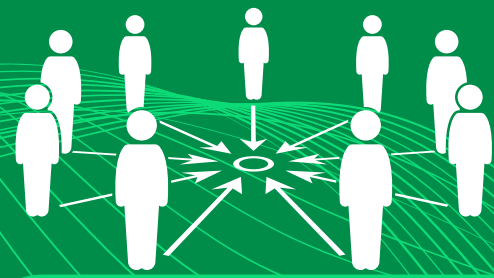


Freedom of Assembly

January to December 2023



The Fundamental Freedoms Monitoring Project (FFMP) systematically monitors Cambodians' ability to exercise their freedoms of association, expression, and assembly. This dashboard presents key findings on **freedom of assembly** drawn from the FFMP's Annual Report 2023: Cambodia Fundamental Freedom Monitor. The FFMP recorded 134 incidents related to freedom of assembly, with 74% classified as restrictions and 25% classified as violations. Notably, the FFMP documented a protection incident where 500 Candlelight Party members gathered in Phnom Penh to demand an explanation for the removal of officials. Local authorities assisted with traffic management at the gathering location.

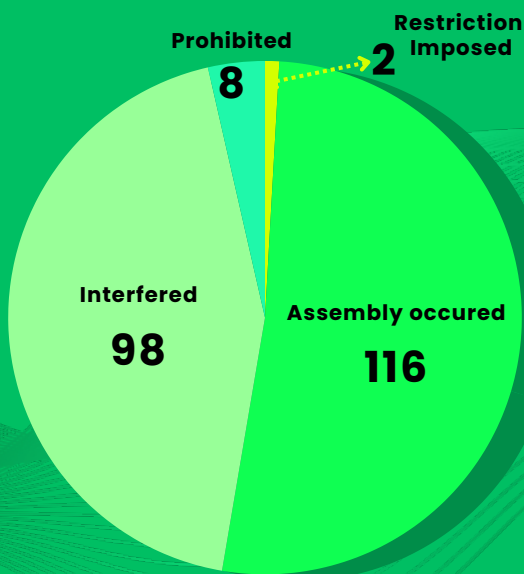
Protection Restriction Violation



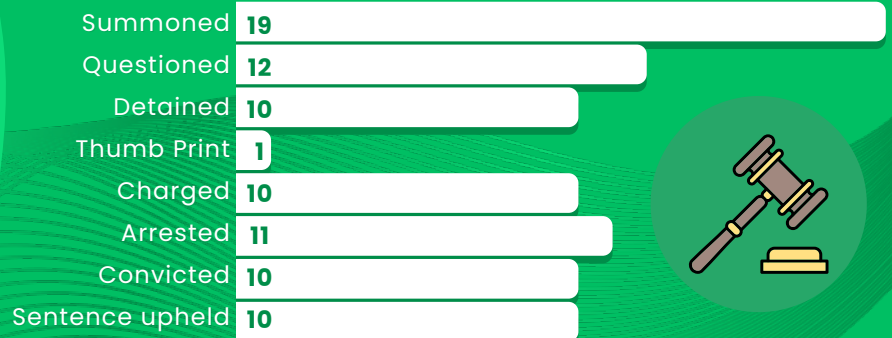
Incidents related to freedom of assembly in 2023



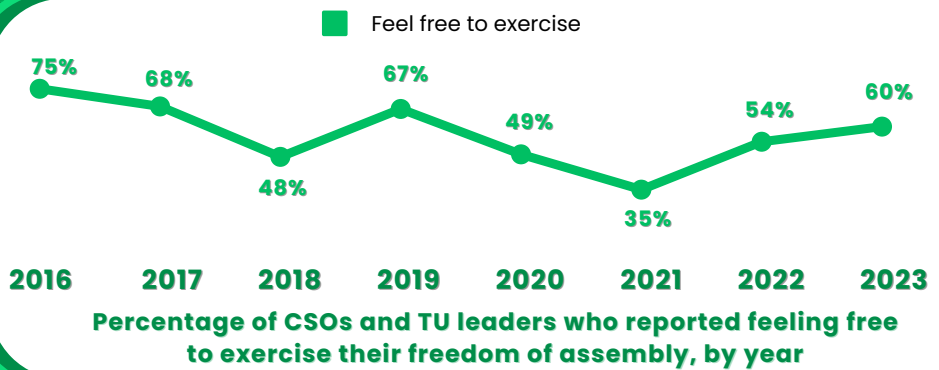
Restrictions/Violations of Freedom of Assembly by Sector



Number of Incident related to freedom of assembly in 2023

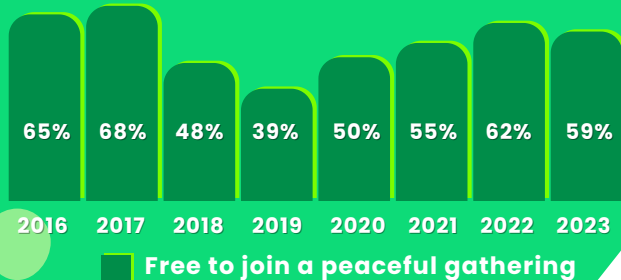


Criminal Sanctions imposed on individuals exercising their rights to freedom of assembly
